


### NDHIN WELCOMES NEW TEAM MEMBER

#### HOW HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGES BOOST VALUE-BASED CARE

In the ever-changing world of healthcare, many providers have turned their attention on value-based care concepts. <u>What is value-based care?</u> Value-based care is a form of reimbursement that aligns payment for the care delivered with the quality of care provided, ultimately rewarding the provider their efficiency and effectiveness. Unlike the traditional fee-for-service care model, value-based care models focus on patient outcomes and provider's proficiency in delivering quality care to their patients consistently.
