 - Electronic Laboratory Reporting

 - School Immunization Requirements


- Immunization Bi-Directional Feed with NDIIS
 - 43 Hospitals/49 Clinic Data Feeds
- Electronic Laboratory Reporting – Reportable Conditions
 - 40 Hospital Data Feeds
- Syndromic Surveillance (Data to CDC for Outbreak Monitoring)
 - 43 Hospital Data Feeds
- Autism Registry



NDHIN & NDIIS

- North Dakota Immunization Information System (NDIIS)
- Confidential, population-based, computerized information system that attempts to collect vaccination data about all North Dakotans
- NDIIS Immunizations folder displays collected vaccination data for adult patients as well as children
- Displays immunization record as well as immunization forecast



NDHIN COVID-19 PANDEMIC RESPONSE SUPPORT


- COVID-19 test results are available in the NDHIN cumulative patient record
 - Alerts functionality has been used for positive case monitoring
 - ETOR for COVID-19 test ordering and resulting with the ND State Lab
 - COVID-19 lab reporting to CDC
- 

NDHIN COVID-19 PANDEMIC RESPONSE SUPPORT

- The ND Department of Health Division of Microbiology was the first lab in ND to perform COVID-19 tests
- An interface with the lab was established in May 2020 and test results are now a part of the NDHIN cumulative health record




ETOR (ELECTRONIC TEST ORDERS & RESULTS)

- Manages test orders coming into the state laboratory and results going back out to the ordering facility
 - Includes a large out-of-state reference lab
 - Full path of ordering and resulting
 - HL7-based interface
 - A test order message (ORM) goes out from the ordering facility
 - A test result message (ORU) goes back to the ordering facility
 - Able to be imported into an electronic health record

ETOR (ELECTRONIC TEST ORDERS & RESULTS)

- **Implementations:**
 - Altru Health (Main + 14 sites)
 - Trinity Health (Main + 4 sites)
 - Northern Plains Reference Lab (CHI St. Alexius, MidDakota + Numerous Sites)
 - Sanford Health (in progress)
- 

CELR (COVID-19 ELECTRONIC LAB REPORTING TO CDC)

- Using CELR, the CDC will be able to aggregate laboratory data from public health departments, private laboratories, and public health laboratories
 - How It Gets Done
 - CELR data comes into the Department of Health for ELR reporting
 - A copy of these messages is routed to the NDHIN
 - NDHIN created a naming and batching convention based on the standard from the Association of Public Health Labs (APHL)
 - NDHIN reports from their rhapsody engine to CDC via the APHL AIMS platform in batches of 1000 messages or every hour, whichever comes first.
